

The next TAG PTA General Meeting will be  
**Tuesday Nov 14, 2017\* at 6pm** in the TAG cafeteria.

At this meeting, elections will be held for  
**7 newly created officer roles.**

\*Due to a change to the PTA bylaws, approved by the membership on Oct 3, 2017, all PTA general meetings will now take place on **the second Tuesday of the month**, instead of the 1st Tuesday, as previously done.

**At the November 14th meeting, the PTA will be holding elections for the newly created officer positions** (created by the bylaw amendment approved on Oct 3). These positions have previously been called committee chair positions but to be in compliance, we needed to create officer positions for each. This election will only be to fill these positions for the rest of the 2017-18 school year and any current committee chairs interested in continuing will be nominated for their respective positions; however, this election is open to any interested TAG parents.

**The election will be for the following 7 positions:**

- 1. Vice President of Audit:** Responsible for Audit Committee that conducts internal and external audits, as needed.
- 2. Vice President of Budget:** Responsible for Budget Committee that drafts and presents yearly PTA budget.
- 3. Vice President of Communications:** Responsible for the Communications Committee that provides information to the parent body via email, newsletters, PTA website and social media.
- 4. Vice President of Enrichment:** Responsible for the Enrichment Committee which enhances the enrichment programs offered to TAG students.
- 5. Vice President of Family Engagement:** Responsible for the Family Engagement Committee (formerly known as Membership) that encourages parent participation, outreach and recruitment.
- 6. Vice President of Fundraising:** Responsible for the Fundraising Committee that coordinates fundraising events and activities to generate funds for the TAG PTA.
- 7. Vice President of Grants:** Responsible for the Grants Committee that pursues grants funding to bring money into the school by researching opportunities, and preparing and submitting grants.

Each of these positions can be held by co-officers and any co-officers running for these offices must run together as a slate. Because this is an expedited election, no nominating committee is formed and all nominations will be taken from the floor.
