Fundraising Update

iPledge Update

- As of Jan 2019, we've received \$102,206 in donations. This is 35% less (-\$55,694) than what was raised for iPledge at the same time last year!
 Total participation this year is only 22% versus 40% from last year. We need your help!
- iPledge is our main fundraiser of the year, with a goal of \$250,000. That's 83% of the PTA's total \$300,000 budget. Our goal is 100% participation.
- Who will win? Class K-113 is in the lead to win the Pizza and Cupcake party with 58% participation, followed by 2-124 with 47% participation! Class 1-121 is leading the race for the most donated funds followed by K-113 again!
- The deadline for donations to be included in the race for Pizza and Cupcake party is extended to January 31st. Find out how your class is doing here.








Apple & Pumpkin Picking was a hit!
